Vote on Change in Registry Provider

For the past few years, representatives of the CMSS have been involved in discussions with Holstein Canada and the other Canadian breed societies regarding the potential of Holstein Canada providing registry services to the other dairy breeds. Starting in January 2013, Holstein Canada began providing registry service for the Canadienne breed while also starting to review and rebuild their own registry system. At this point, our breed was invited to be part of a consultation process on what our breed would need/expect in a registry system, and explore whether there is a desire to move our registry service provider to Holstein Canada.

Most members of the CMSS are also members of Holstein Canada. Moving our registry service to Holstein Canada would aim to provide more accurate and timely service, a more complete registry service (including electronic registration), and more tools for the breed secretary/field service staff in providing service direct to members. There have also been indications that the cost to the breed for registry services will be significantly reduced by moving service to Holstein Canada.

The membership previously voted at the 2011 AGM to support continued discussions on multi-breed registry services. At the 2014 AGM in Lindsay, the membership will be asked to vote on whether or not they wish to see registry service move to Holstein Canada on January 1st, 2016. To ensure that your voice is heard on this issue and to get more information, members are encouraged to attend the Field Day and AGM this July in Lindsay. If you are not able to attend, feel free to contact Ryan to discuss the issue.
